RED Team Accomplishments January – December, 2015

- The RED Team reviewed and approved the 2015 CEDS Status Update for submittal to Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration in January of 2015.
- 3. The RED Team spent three of the six meetings and time in between meetings working on the **2016 Five-Year CEDS** including developing a regional SWOT, the overall mission .of the region, goals objectives and strategies/ action items, establishing priorities and developing the implementation matrix including a timeline and potential partners. This draft was completed by the RED Team in December of 2015 prior to the 30 day public comment period before approval in 2016.
- 4. The RED Team took on the outreach role for the MSU Extension SEA grant Community Resiliency Assessment & Strategies project in our region. The outreach included inviting the project manager to local meetings and encouraging participation in a survey in the fall of 2015. The survey outreach resulted in over 300 responses, which was 50% above the target number. The survey results will be evaluated for the next phase of this project.
- The RED Team took on the outreach role for the GVSU/EMCOG SPROUT Lab Initiative. Three RED Team members participated in training and became certified facilitators for the classes.
- 6. The RED Team functioned as the outreach group for the **MSU Extension Citizen Planner** courses which were held at the Tuscola County EDC office and Isabella County offices. RED Team members served on the organization committee, hosted the classes and helped with the outreach for this program.
- 7. The RED Team played a key role in the outreach to promote the June, 2015 Empowering ALICE Regional Summit at SVSU which was a collaborative effort of the United Way of Michigan, Saginaw County and EMCOG. Approximately 170 people attended the one day summit.
