Gary Kellan, Oscoda-Wurtsmith Airport Authority

They are still working with the Michigan Launch Initiative to potentially develop a horizontal launch site at the Oscoda-Wurtsmith Airport.

Kathy Methner, Independent Consultant

She is part of a group that is forming a broadband in Beaverton and the surrounding area; also in Roscommon County. The moving of the Arenac County Fairgrounds to its new location is progressing. Both Midland and Gladwin Counties have formed long term flood relief groups to assist people who have been affected by the failure of the dams in Gladwin and Midland Counties. They are hiring two Case Managers (one for Midland and one for Gladwin) through UMCOR to work with the people who need assistance and connect them with the resources available. We have several committees working on funding, infrastructure, volunteerism, communication and others. They are both very active groups but still getting organized. The UMCOR case managers will be of great benefit once they are trained.

Meaghan Gass, Sea Grant Extension Educator, MSU Extension

A *High Water on the Great Lakes* webinar is coming up on July 22nd. If you register you will receive a link to the recording even if you cannot participate on July 22nd. She is developing a "Go With the Flow" google classroom for grades K-12 for classroom instruction.

Bill Wright, representing several environmental organizations
